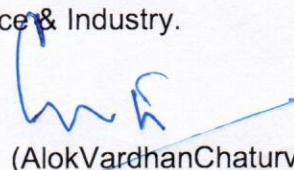
Subject: Amendment in import policy and policy condition of pepper classified under Chapter 09 of ITC (HS), 2017–Schedule–1(Import Policy).
